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Introduction

Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAF) will have to play a major role if the aviation sector is to meet its climate goals.

However, to date, commercialization has been slow and current policies have proved inadequate to accelerate commercialization and widespread deployment of the various technologies described in the report.
